### end up

**Meaning:** To finally be in a particular place or situation, often unexpectedly.

### **Examples:**

- We planned to go to Paris, but we **ended up** in Rome instead.
- If you don't study, you might **end up** failing the test.

### thriving

Meaning: Doing very well; growing or succeeding.

### **Examples:**

- Her business is **thriving**, and she is making a lot of money.
- After moving to a new city, he is **thriving** in his new job.

### see ourselves

**Meaning:** To imagine or picture oneself in a particular situation or place.

### **Examples:**

- We didn't **see ourselves** staying in our hometown forever.
- She sees herself as a future entrepreneur.

### childhood

**Meaning:** The period of life when a person is a child.

## **Examples:**

- We have been friends since **childhood**.
- She spent her **childhood** playing in the countryside.

### kind of

**Meaning:** A phrase used to show uncertainty or partial agreement.

### **Examples:**

- I **kind of** want to go out, but I'm also tired.
- He **kind of** likes his job, but he wants something better.

### that's honestly

**Meaning:** A phrase used to express truthfulness or personal opinion.

### **Examples:**

- That's honestly the best pizza I've ever had!
- That's honestly why I decided to move to another country.
