**Meaning:** A phrase used to say that something is always a good choice. **Examples:** 

- You can't go wrong with a classic chocolate chip cookie.
- If you're looking for a great movie, **you can't go wrong** with this one.

### There's plenty more where that came from

**Meaning:** There is a lot more of something available. **Examples:** 

- If you love chocolate, there's plenty more where that came from!
- Don't worry about running out of snacks—there's plenty more where that came from.

### number one priority

**Meaning:** The most important thing to someone. **Examples:** 

- Finishing my assignment is my **number one priority** today.
- Her number one priority is spending time with her family.

**Meaning:** There are many things to mention. **Examples:** 

- When it comes to my favorite foods, the list is long.
- The list is long, but my top travel destinations are Japan, Italy, and France.
